ITINERARY: (B: Breakfast, L: Lunch, D: Dinner)

DAY 1

Embark on your journey with a direct flight from San Francisco to Hong Kong.

DAY 2 (L, D) Shunde

After landing, we transfer from Hong Kong to Shunde, and a welcome lunch at Ah Yee Lan Tong Restaurant. After lunch we will visit Qing Hui Yuan Garden and tour old town

Shunde, well known for its street foods such as crispy Shunde donuts and steamed sweet layered milk custard. In the evening we are invited to a spectacular banquet prepared by the top master Cantonese chefs in Shunde's popular Happy Together Restaurant.

DAY 3 (B, L, D) Shunde - Panyu

After breakfast in hotel, we shop at a local market for seafood, produce, fruits, spices and other exotic ingredients needed in our first cooking class - to get acquainted with the basic Chinese cooking tools and to learn about local and exotic ingredients. Enjoy dinner at one of the popular local restaurants.

DAY 4 (B, L, D) Panyu

Breakfast in hotel. Visit a traditional Baomo Yuan Garden and Panyu's world-renowned silk factories. See how silk is made, from the silkworm to the loom. Lunch at a local Cantonese restaurant, where we will take an exclusive behind-the-scenes kitchen tour. Dinner will include a cooking demo followed by an elaborate banquet dinner at the Yumizhixiang Restaurant.

DAY 5 (B, D) Panyu - Guangzhou - Yunnan

Travel by bus from Panyu to Guangzhou airport and arrive at Lijiang. Upon arrival, we will be greeted by our local representative and transferred to check in Guangfang Hotel. In the evening, we enjoy the sights of the historical Lijiang old town, and dine at the Wangfu Banquet restaurant.

DAY 6 (B, L, D) Lijiang, Yunnan

Explore the well-preserved Naxi ethnic minority culture. Today we will catch our first glimpse of the majestic 18,260 ft. Jade Dragon Snow Mountain. Take a cable car to the Spruce Meadow, well walled by thick Yunnan Spruce, and the perfect scenic point to marvel at the magnificence of the Jade Dragon Snow Mountain. In the afternoon, we will visit one of the seven largest monasteries in Lijiang, Yufeng Lamasery. Dinner is a local special - Mushroom Hot Pot.

DAY 7 (B, L, D) Lijiang, Yunnan

The highlight of today's tour is the Old Town of Lijiang. We will explore its history dating back more than 800 years. Also known as Dayan Town, the old town of Lijiang is characterized by the crisscross pebble stone streets, crystal clear canals, red wooden houses along the streets and the flow of rivers. Old Town has been designated by the UN as a world cultural Heritage Site. After Old Town, we proceed to visit the picturesque Black Dragon Pool and Dongba Cultural Museum.

DAY 8 (B, L, D) Lijiang - Guangzhou - Shenzhen

Today we bid farewell to beautiful Lijiang. After breakfast, we board our bus transfer to the airport for our flight to Guangzhou. We will enjoy a late lunch and chef demo in a traditional rice noodle restaurant. Hands-on dim sum class and dinner at "Happy Dim Sum" Restaurant Guangzhou. Transfer to Shenzhen and check into hotel.

DAY 9 (B, L, D) Shenzhen

Breakfast in hotel. Lunch at a local restaurant. After lunch, we will take a tour to the Splendid China Theme park and enjoy a cultural performance. Dinner at Baguobuyi Sichuan Restaurant, where we will also enjoy a spectacular performance of The Magic Masks Dance (originated from the Sichuan Opera).

DAY 10 (B) Shenzhen - Hong Kong

After breakfast, we will shuttle to Hong Kong by coach and check into Harbour Plaza Metropolis Hotel. Free time in the afternoon and evening to enjoy this Pearl of the Orient.

DAY 11 (B, D) Hong Kong

After breakfast at the hotel, we will take a city tour that includes Stanley Market, Aberdeen, Manmo Temple, and Victoria Peak. Last minute shopping & personal sightseeing in the afternoon. Our farewell dinner will be held at Liyumen fishing village.

DAY 12 (B)

After breakfast, we will board our bus for Hong Kong International Airport to catch our San Francisco flight.
